GRAPPLE TRUCK AND BACKHOE BREAK DOWN TRACK PANELS

Project Description

The railroad had more than 30 damaged track panels that needed to be demolished. Hulcher deployed a grapple truck and backhoe to perform this three-day project. The crew broke down the track panels into rails and ties. The grapple truck moved the rails into a storage area as the backhoe used its cribbing bucket to remove the metal plates from the ties. Hulcher's crew inspected the ties for damage and separated them into separate stacks in the storage area, making it easy for the railroad to recyle or reuse the ties. Once the rails and ties had been separated and stacked, the grapple truck used its magnet attachment to pick up the plates and other metal scraps for recycling.
